Directions:

From Toronto, Ottawa and Montreal: Follow Highway 401 west to Interchange 278 at Kitchener. Follow Highway 8 west through Kitchener; join Highway 7/8 west to Stratford. The Festival Inn is on the right hand side, just as you enter the city of Stratford.

From London and Windsor: Follow Highway 401 east to Exit 222. Follow County Road # 6 north to Stratford. As you enter the Stratford City limits, turn right on Ontario Street. The Festival Inn is on the left across from the Festival Marketplace Shopping Mall.

From St. Catharines, Stoney Creek and Hamilton: Follow the Queen Elizabeth Way across the Burlington Skyway to Exit 100 west on Highway 403. Take Highway 403 west to the Highway 6 exit, and head north towards Guelph. Follow Highway 6 to Highway 401 at the village of Morriston. Proceed west on Highway 401, exiting at Interchange 278 on to Highway 8 west at Kitchener. Follow Highway 8 west into Kitchener to Highway 7/8 west to Stratford. The Festival Inn is on the right just as you enter the city of Stratford.

- ❖ The Trial Secretary is in full charge of the Trials
- ❖ The show precincts shall consist of 30 feet around the ring area
- ❖ Food or toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course. Ring Surface is grass
- ❖ The ring area will be enclosed in fencing on four sides with roped Entrance/Exit openings.
- ❖ Handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class.
- ❖ Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent.
- ❖ Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2006.
- ❖ To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN)
- ❖ Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the hotel venue. Dogs are not to be permitted off-leash on the Festival Inn grounds at any time.
- ❖ Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.
- ❖ Rosettes/ribbons will be given for 1st to 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights.
- ❖ Food may be purchased in the hotel restaurant.

Liability Agreement

I (we) acknowledge that the The Golden Retriever Club of Canada has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this agility trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to fold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

- ❖ *The owner or handler of the dog must sign the Liability Agreement on the back of the entry form. Incomplete entries will be returned*
- ❖ *Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by correct fees.*
- ❖ *Fax /Online entries will be accepted with a valid Visa or MasterCard number with a processing fee of 10% of the total entry*
- ❖ *Courier entries will be accepted if no signature is required*
- ❖ *Move-ups will be allowed after the closing date*
- ❖ *Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made*
- ❖ *Judging schedules, emailed or faxed as soon as possible after the closing date.*
- ❖ *Tendering of NSF cheque or declined credit card is considered as non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.*

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN must be applied for within thirty (30) days of the first day of entering a CKC event. The ERN Fee is \$53.50 per dog. For further information contact the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheque will not be accepted. Personal cheque will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark personal cheque "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds or pay Credit Card.. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated..
